Download the app


To download the Guidebook app, please follow any of the steps below, depending upon your preferred device.

- Open up the Apple, Google or Amazon app store on your device. Then search for “Guidebook.” When you have found it, tap to download and install the Guidebook app.

Access the STEM Research and Career Symposium guide on the Guidebook app

- Tap on the Guidebook app to open it.
- Either click in the field *Find guides* or tap the magnifying glass to access the search box.
- Type in the name of the guide: **2018 STEM Research and Career Symposium**
- Click or tap to download and open the guide.

Navigation and features

- Tap on the  icon in the top-left corner of the screen to access the navigation menu.
- Some of the features that are important for you to know are:
 - **Agenda.** Click on a particular date (September 30 – October 2) for that day’s schedule of events and locations.
 - **Keynote Speakers.** Read about our keynote speakers.
 - **Oral Presentations.** Read the abstracts of each author’s presentation.
 - **Poster Presentations.** Read the abstracts of each author’s presentation.
 - **Breakout Sessions.** Click on the title of an event for the session description and time.
 - **Maps.** Included are:
 - Lunch table layout/program table assignment for lunch with programs.
 - Poster sessions maps that tell you where posters are located, according to abstract category.
 - A map of the Emory Conference Center floorplan.

After you have closed the app

To navigate back to Symposium content after you’ve closed the app, simply click on the Guidebook app, if using a mobile device or tablet. The Symposium should now appear in “My Guides.” If it doesn’t, simply repeat the steps above.
